

COOKIES POLICY

This website, like most websites on the Internet, uses cookies to improve and enhance browsing experience.

Below you will find detailed information about what cookies are, what kind of cookies there are, which ones are used by this website, how you can disable them from your browser, and how to block the installation of third party cookies.

By pressing Accept, you are agreeing to accept cookies from our website on your computer or mobile device.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files sent to your browser by the websites you visit. They help the website store information about your visit, retaining only information related to your preferences, as such not including your personal data. The placement of cookies will help the website recognize your device the next time the user visits.

We use the term cookies in this policy to refer to all files that collect information in this manner.

The cookies used do not collect information that identifies the user. The cookies collect general information, including how users get to the website, the language they use, and how they use websites, or the zone of the country through which they access the website, etc. Cookies retain only information related to your preferences. The user can decide to be notified of the receipt of cookies through the web browser at any given time and block their entry into their system.

Refusing to use cookies on this website may result in the inability to access some of the areas or receive personalized information.

WHAT ARE COOKIES USED FOR?

Cookies are used to help determine the usefulness, interest, and number of uses of websites, allowing for a faster and more efficient navigation, eliminating the need to repeatedly enter the same information.

WHAT KIND OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

We use different types of cookies that have different functions. For example:

Strictly necessary cookies (essential)

They allow for navigation on the website and the use of their applications, as well as access to secure areas of the website. Without these cookies, requested services cannot be provided. Some cookies are essential to access specific areas of our website.

Analytical Cookies

These cookies are used to analyze how users use the website and monitor the performance. This allows us to provide a high quality experience by customizing our offer and quickly identifying and fixing any problems that arise. For example, we use performance cookies to find out the most popular pages, which method of connection between pages is more effective, or to determine why some pages are receiving error messages. These cookies are only used for the purpose of creating and analyzing statistics, without ever collecting personal information.

Functional Cookies

These will track the user's preferences regarding the use of the website so that it is not necessary to configure the website each time the visitor goes there.

Third Party Cookies

These measure the success of applications and the effectiveness of third party advertising. They may also be used in order to customize a widget with the user data.

Moreover, cookies can be:

Permanent Cookies - These are stored for a variable time in the internet browser in the access devices (PC, mobile phone, and tablet) and are used whenever the user visits a new website. They are generally used to direct the navigation according to user interests, enabling us to provide a more personalized service.

Session Cookies - These are temporary cookies that remain on your internet browser until the website is closed. The information collected allows us to identify problems and provide a better browsing experience.

HOW TO DISABLE THE USE OF COOKIES

If so desired, it is possible to stop accepting browser cookies or stop accepting cookies from any specific service.

All modern browsers allow you to change the settings of the cookies. These settings are usually found in the "Options" or "Preferences" in the browser menu.
